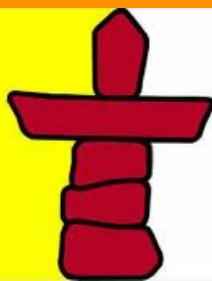


Join Our Employment Journey!

Healthy Living Corner

Kale Chips Recipe (2 Servings)
1 bunch of fresh kale (or 1/2 pound)
2 teaspoons olive oil
Salt to taste

Heat oven to 500 F (Broil). Line rimmed cookie sheets with aluminum foil. Tear leaves off the thick stems into chip-sized pieces.

Put the leaves into a bowl and drizzle with olive oil and sprinkle on salt to taste.

Bake for 5 minutes or until edges are brown and the kale is crispy when moved in the pan.

Remove from the oven and enjoy!!

1. Sit or stand with your feet slightly apart.
2. Place your hands on your shoulders with your elbows at shoulder level and pointing out.

Slowly make a circle with your elbows. Breathe out as you start the circle and breathe in as you complete the circle.
