About the Community Disability Support Worker (CDSW) Program

The *Community Disability Support Worker* is a full-time, licensed and comprehensive 11-week program. It provides students with the theoretical and practical skills and knowledge needed to secure entry-level employment in community disability services.

Entry level workers assist those with disabling conditions find stimulating activities and environments to engage with in the community. They also help in performing daily living activities.

If you are patient, friendly, and care about helping those with challenging needs reach their optimal level of functioning, this program is for you!

In addition to the *Community Disability Support Worker Certificate*, graduates will also receive certifications in WHMIS, Fire Suppression, First Aid/CPR, and Food Safety.
